



USPAV 18 MAINTAINS STATE BRAGGING RIGHTS BY WINNING SHAMROCK FESTIVAL

Richmond, VA (March 15, 2010) - U-Turn Sports Performance Academy's Volleyball (USPAV) 18U girl's team won the 18's division of the 2010 Shamrock Volleyball Festival. USPAV survived the tournament by going undefeated for the two day event with a record of 8-0 defeating Yorktowne 18 Cheetahs of Penn in the finals score of 25/22 and 25/23.

The 2010 Shamrock Festival held March 13th -14th in the Roanoke Valley for teams in the 14, 16, and 18 & under age divisions. The 2010 Shamrock Festival saw 228 teams competing from VA, NC, PA, MD, TN, SC, WV, DE, & NY and included teams from 8 different USAV regions. Historically, Shamrock has attracted teams from as far north as NY & NJ and as far south as GA & FL. The Shamrock Festival is the largest nationally-sanctioned USAV tournament held in Virginia and one of the premier volleyball events for juniors on the East Coast.
